



## Douglas Albert Perry Sr.,

August 12, 1944 - May 3, 2024

Douglas Albert Perry passed away on May 3, 2024, at the age of 79.

Doug was born on August 12, 1944, and was raised in Gary, Indiana. After graduation from Lew Wallace High School, in March of 1962, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and was trained to be Radio Repairman.

Doug enjoyed his hobbies of photography, video production, fishing, boating, gardening, music, classic cars (Hot Rods) and being with family members.

Doug spent his entire 60 plus year career working in the Radio Communications industry, including 4 years in the Air Force plus 2 years in the Air Force Reserves.

During Doug's career, he provided Radio Engineering Services primarily for Public Safety agencies, such as Law Enforcement, EMS, Fire and Emergency Management organizations. Over the last 30 years, Doug developed technical engineering software for the communications industry to help resolve radio interference between communication systems. He continued this work until his passing.

Doug is survived by his six Children. Douglas Albert Perry, Jr., Debbie Lynn Perry, Pamella Lynne (Perry) Riley, Phillip Daniel Perry, Andrew Michael

Perry, Brynne Elizabeth (Perry) Farrell, and 11 Grandchildren.
