



Elizabeth Duggin Davenport

June 15, 1933 - March 24, 2019

Mary Elizabeth “Lib” Duggin Davenport passed away peacefully on March 24, 2019 at 85 years of age in Huntsville, Alabama. She was the sixth child born to Houston and Gertie Duggin on June 15, 1933, in Cannon County, Tennessee.

Lib graduated from Woodbury High School in 1951. She married pilot Milan Davenport on April 5, 1953 – he was the only person she would fly in an airplane with. Together, they moved around the Southeast residing in Biloxi, MS, San Antonio, TX, Humboldt, TN, and finally Guntersville, AL, where they lived for over 40 years. Lib retired from Marshall Medical Center, but her favorite job was being a mother to her three sons and one daughter and “Grandma” to her seven grandchildren. She believed her grandchildren could do no wrong. Her love language to her family was food, and she spent a majority of her time baking treats for her grandchildren and their friends. Lib will be remembered by her family as one of the kindest, most selfless people you could ever meet, and she will be sorely missed.
