Anderson and his wife, Jenna; two granddaughters, Jessica Waits (Richard) and Elizabeth

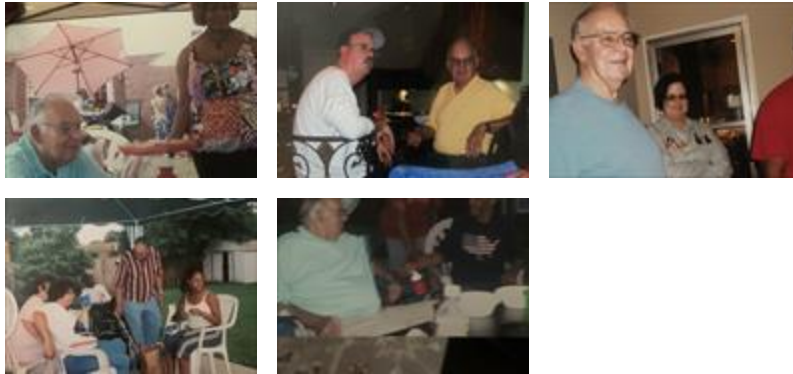
Barnett; and a host of nieces, nephews, family, and friends that he left an everlasting mark on and
