



## Jo Evelyn Gray

May 2, 1946 - September 11, 2024

Jo Evelyn Gray of Guntersville passed away on September 11, 2024, at the age of 78.

She is survived by her husband of 56 years, Gary Gray; daughter, Allison Fuller of Huntsville, and granddaughter Abigail Fuller of Huntsville.

Jo was preceded in death by her parents, Allison and Maxine Adkins and sister, Jerrie Nuckols of Huntsville.

She was a dedicated elementary teacher for 38 years, teaching in Auburn, Huntsville, Bel Air Maryland, Arab, and Guntersville, with 30 of her years serving as a second-grade teacher at Guntersville Elementary School.

Jo received numerous awards during her devoted career as an educator. She was named to the Jacksonville State Teacher Hall of Fame for the 79-80 school year, named the Guntersville Chamber of Commerce Educator of the Year in 1987, and received the Governor's Award for the Education Category in 1998 for her work promoting the PALS program (People Against a Littered State) at Guntersville Elementary School.

In addition to being a dedicated teacher, she also served on the Board of Directors for the Guntersville Christian Women's Job Corps.

Jo was an adored wife, mother, grandmother, and friend who will leave a large void in her family and community.

Services will be held at the Guntersville First Baptist Church, Sunday, September 15, with visitation at 1:00 PM, and her service at 2:00 PM.
