degree at Samford University in 1962. He worked at several local drug stores until he and his

brother, Lloyd, built and opened Darnell Pharmacy in Albertville in 1976. They practiced there

until they retired in 1996.

Having never married, "Jo Jo" spent his latter years caring for his family's farm. His life was

changed when the April 27th tornadoes destroyed most of the trees there. He was an excellent

sketch artist and wood carver. He was an eccentric Southern bachelor who enjoyed hard

work, Mark Twain, congregational "fa-sol-la" singing, genealogy and remembering the past.

He was a member of the AL National Guard for 10 years, the AL

and the Baptist church.
