is limited due to the pandemic.

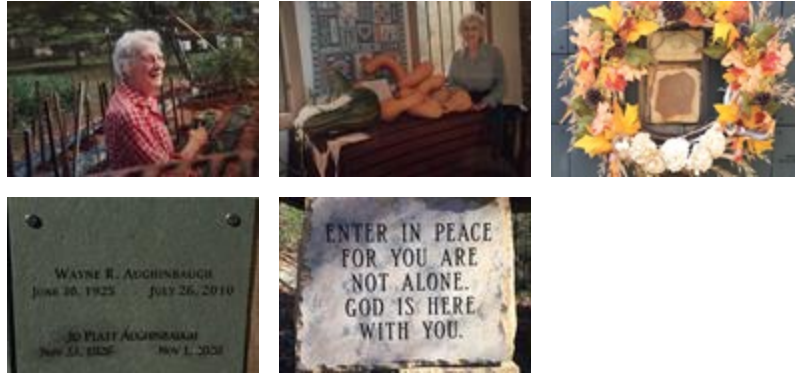

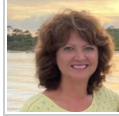

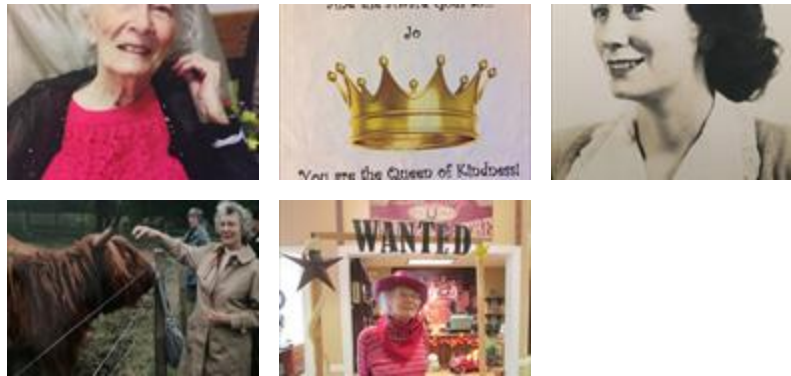
