



Judy Perry Benton

March 29, 1944 - August 24, 2022

Elizabeth Judy Perry Benton, age 78, died peacefully on August 24, 2022, surrounded by her children in Huntsville Hospital, where she had courageously fought serious illness for seven weeks.

Judy was born on March 29, 1944, in Blount Springs, Alabama. Her family moved to Guntersville when she was eight years-old. Judy attended Marshall County High School, where she was a cheerleader. She lived in Guntersville for 30 years, where she raised her family and was an active member of Victory Baptist church -serving as a Sunday School teacher and member of the choir. In later days, Judy lived in Homewood, Alabama, where she served as Executive Office Manager for the Alabama Independent Automobile Dealers' Association (AIADA). She and her husband were members of the Second Presbyterian Church. Upon her husband's death in 2020, Judy returned to Guntersville to be near most of her children and grandchildren. After returning to Guntersville, Judy became a member of the First Baptist Church of Guntersville, and assisted with The Place Ministry, a ministry which helps provide clothing and necessities for foster children.

Rauschenberg, and her husband, Frank Benton Sr.
