Michael Paul Lynch of Guntersville, Alabama passed away on February 15, 2025 at Shepherd's Cove Hospice in Albertville after an extended illness. He was 73. He was born to his parents Lela and Troy Lynch in Geraldine. Before he was nine, both his parents had passed away and he was raised by his sister and brother-in-law who were both handicapped. He was their main caregiver for the remainder of their lives. Mike loved to work and had experience in several different fields including leather work, making small furniture and painting cars. He ended his career working for M & S Construction until he became disabled in 2006. He enjoyed the outdoors and going for a hike in the woods at the State Park with friends. He was especially fond of the Great Smoky Mountains. His greatest joy came from dedicating his life to serve his God, Jehovah in 1968 and following the footsteps of Jesus Christ in the ministry work. He is survived by his wife, Willette; on February 21 they would have been married 44 years. He is also survived by his sister Judy (Sam) Viola of Rochester, NY; a brother, Joel Lynch, of Thomasville, GA, and several nieces and nephews.
