Ophelia Chandler died on Thursday, August 1, 2024, at the age of 81. She was born on July 4, 1943, to the late Robert L. and Evelyn Milner Poe of Guntersville. She was employed forty years with Gold Kist Poultry (now Pilgrim's) as the Human Resources Manager. She served on several Civic and Industrial boards including: The Industrial Board of Guntersville, The Marshall-Jackson Mental Health Board, the Advisory Board of Food & Science Department, Tuskegee University, The Guntersville City Board of Education, and the Guntersville City Museum Board of Directors.
