Mr. Robert Dean Dekker, age 75, of Guntersville, Alabama, passed away peacefully in his home, on July 17, 2020. He was born October 27, 1944, in Midland Michigan, a son of the late Cecil Mae Bezon and Harold Dekker, of Holland Michigan. Serving as a combat Marine in Vietnam, he was awarded the Cross of Gallantry with Palm medal. He was a devoted husband and long term resident of Fountain Valley, California, where he and wife Sandi Wesighan, of Sussex County, New Jersey raised their two children. He was married for 54 years and worked for Lockheed Martin, in Marietta, Georgia, before retiring in 2006 to the serene lake settings of Guntersville. He was an avid outdoors-man, who enjoyed camping, boating and woodcraft. He was preceded in death by his wife, mother, father, and brother, Randall John Dekker, of Edmond, Oklahoma.
