MARKS, William – Nearly 13 months to the day after the death of his wife of 56 years, William “Bill” Joseph Marks died on April 10, 2015 at the age of 79. Bill was born in Atlanta, Georgia to Bertie and William G. Marks in 1935. He spent most of his childhood in Nashville, TN where he graduated in 1958 from Vanderbilt University.
